NAVIGATORS



raying, fasting, reading the Qur'an—from a young age, Najib grew up like any other Egyptian Muslim. But during his adolescence, he found himself on a dangerous path. His testimony is a story of God's relentless pursuit, His ability to soften the hardest of hearts, and Leading The Way's role in God's grander plan.

"All the teaching was blood, fighting, killing, and violence. There was no forgiveness, no mercy," Najib said.

Although he grew up in a traditional Muslim family, as a young teen Najib found himself ensnared in the dangerous ideology of the Muslim Brotherhood.

became a kind of extremist," he said, "[but] I found a voice inside me telling me that what I was doing was wrong something pulling me away from Islam."

Najib began combing through the Qur'an for answers. He vent to three sheikhs, but each one evaded his questions. He retreated from the Islamic community. He stopped fasting, praying, and going to the mosque. He stopped acknowledging God's existence entirely

"I felt life was darkening before me," he said. "The hatred inside me was evident. When people looked at me, it was as if they had seen the devil himself. They were so afraid of me."

Then, something unexpected happened—something God would se as the definitive turning point in Najib's life.





For six weeks, Najib was ill and bedridden. Now, the calling out to him again.

"I heard a voice calling to me from within. I cannot describe the voice because it was so beautiful," Najib said. "A cross suddenly appeared before me—a huge cross with bright light. I asked, 'Who are you?' The voice answered, 'I am your Lord Jesus Christ.'"

When Najib awoke, he was no longer sick. He remembered the cross appearing to him the night before. From that moment on, the most important thing was to find out the truth.

"I started crying out, 'Lord, reveal the truth to me," Najib said.

A TIMELY MESSAGE OF TRUTH

Who could Najib ask about the things he had seen and heard? The Christians he knew were afraid of him. But the Lord was not going to let Najib's prayer go unanswered.

"One day I was flipping through the channels when THE KINGDOM SAT came on," Najib said. "I found a sermon from Pastor Michael Youssef. I started understanding the words. This was the Bible that we were made to hate and to reject. But these words were God's words! He was talking about God, His love, forgiveness, and mercy. I found that what I was previously taught as the correct teaching turned out to be the devil's teaching. The words of the Bible entered my heart and touched it. I started craving Pastor Youssef's appearance on the programs, so I would wait for him."

A NEW FAMILY

"I called the number and a brother from the channel answered the phone," Najib said. "I introduced myself and asked for a Bible. He asked how I knew Jesus Christ and what made me reject Islam."



For a year, Najib exchanged messages with a member of *Leading The Way's* follow-up team. Najib would send his questions, and the follow-up team would send him verses in return.

"I stopped believing in Islam. I accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as my personal Savior, to whom is all the glory, and who is the King of kings and the Lord of lords," Najib said. "This brother introduced the answers to me. He taught me everything I wanted to know and answered my questions. With his help, I got baptized and accepted Jesus Christ as my Lord, God, Savior, fortress, and support."

Najib's personal transformation was undeniable—from the neighborhood bully to a man filled with Christlike joy and love for others.

"My whole life changed—from ignorance and backwardness to light and truth, from hatred to love, from insecurity and constant stress to peace that fills my heart," Najib said.

Parents, neighbors, and friends noticed the change in Najib's life. People who had been afraid of him were now drawn to him.

But his newfound joy came at a cost.

"I used to put the Bible under my pillow. While I was out, my mother found it," Najib said. "When I returned, she asked me what it was. I told her, 'I became a Christian. I believe in Jesus Christ'—straight to the point. She asked me, 'Is this for real?' I answered, 'Just as you heard, Mum. . . . I am a believer in Jesus Christ my Savior.'"

Najib's mother went to the kitchen, grabbed a knife, and came to stab him with it.

"The knife hit my hand and injured me. She spat in my face and insulted me. I left home for a few days and went to stay with the brother from the follow-up team for a while. He introduced me to a few brothers who supported me and stood by my side to strengthen me."



WORKING TOGETHER

This is the beauty of Gospel ministry: God is the only one who can change hearts, but we get to be a part of the process.

It was your partnership that enabled *Leading The Way* to proclaim the Gospel message Najib saw on television. It was your partnership that allowed our follow-up teams to answer Najib's questions, lead him to Christ, baptize him, and connect him with the local church. And it was your partnership that, most recently, enabled us to provide for Najib's housing and living expenses as he fled to a safer location. Yet, without God's sovereign orchestration of every detail, we would have never heard his story.

It's a privilege to play a small role in God's grand plan as we broadcast the Gospel, follow up on the ground, and help the persecuted. May these final words from Najib's story be your encouragement that God is doing the impossible through your prayers and gifts—and you are a part of his testimony:

"I thank this ministry for helping people like me move from darkness to light, from hatred to love."



With Dr. Michael Youssef's messages available in 25 languages, the Good News of Jesus is transcending cultural boundaries, religious barriers, and the scars of tragedy. Two Turkish listeners—one hating God, the other imprisoned for murder—shared with us:

"I grew up in a radical Muslim family. I hated God because I thought He didn't love women. I became a feminist. I listened to your program by accident, and I heard for the first time about a God who loves. You talked about the Son of God, that God gave His one and only Son. These words changed my life. Thank vou." - Miriam

"This weekend I listened to your program and wanted to write to you. I'm in jail because I killed someone. I will be here for a long time. Since I've been here, I've had no hope. I thought that I will never be forgiven. I wanted to kill myself. You talked about a God who forgives. I have hope again now. Can He really forgive me and set me free? Is that possible?" - Sayyid



From Sri Lankan villages to homes in *Vietnam—both nations where the Christian* population is less than 10 percent—God is drawing listeners to Himself:

"I work near the Sinharaja forest in Sri Lanka, and there are no churches for many miles. This program is very valuable and perfectly timed. This half an hour is worth so much to me." - Manoi

magine being blind, illiterate, isolated in a rural village or closed country, unexpectedly displaced by war, or persecuted and confined to your home—no Bible, no churches, no community of believers. Then imagine receiving a Bible you could listen to any time, anywhere—God's promises spoken to you in your heart language. Like water to a parched soul, this is the joy Navigator recipients feel the moment they receive their solar-powered audio device for the first time.

Desperate for the Word of God, a blind man named David used to call out for passersby to read him just a few words from the Bible. When he received a *Navigator*, he burst into tears. Finally, he had a Bible he could listen to at any time.



A II across the Muslim world, from Egypt to Indonesia and even here in the West, a movement is growing. It is the handiwork of a gracious and relentless God.

And while you may not hear about it in the news, it is making headlines in heaven as one lost soul after another comes to the saving knowledge of Christ. For seven years, *Leading The Way* has been broadcasting God's Truth into the Middle East and following up on the ground via THE KINGDOM SAT, the ministry's 24/7 satellite TV and internet channel dedicated to reaching the Muslim world with the Gospel.

What we are seeing is more than isolated conversions—it is a sovereign move of God to "bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners" (Isaiah 61:1).



This year, more than 500 people came to Christ at Dr. Youssef's three-day preaching event in Cairo, Egypt.

God is shaking the very foundations of Islam.
Through dreams and visions, He is preparing hearts to receive the Gospel. Through Christ-centered programming tailored for Middle Eastern audiences, He is reaching into closed countries and knocking on the doors of many hearts. Through personal discipleship, He is growing His church.

DISCIPLE MAKING & CHURCH PLANTING

The goal of Leading The Way's outreach to the Muslim world is not to simply make more converts, it is to make disciples. For Christians leaving Islam behind, they are choosing Jesus Christ over their family, culture, and country—and they desperately need the support and guidance of other Christians through this intense and often dangerous process. Through on-the-ground follow-up teams, Leading The Way is providing this support.

"Would you please send me a free Bible link? . . . I am afraid to go to church. I don't have friends to teach me the Bible or answer my questions and am afraid to be killed if I become a Christian." – **YEMEN**

"I had so many questions about the Qur'an and Christianity. However, no one was able to answer any of my questions. I started watching THE KINGDOM SAT programs, especially Dr. Youssef's program, and called the follow-up team. I met a brother who followed up with me, explaining the Truth and answering my questions. He led me to Jesus and I gave my life to Him. The team continued teaching me the Bible. I was baptized, I have been attending church, and I'm so thankful for all you have done for me. My life is changed. I'm on the right track and I'll keep holding on to Jesus even in the hardest of times." – **EGYPT**

Biblically trained, and many equipped with an Islamic background, these teams not only answer calls, emails, and texts from viewers, but also engage in personal discipleship on the ground. In places where no formal churches exist, one-on-one meetings often turn into small home groups, which continue to grow and multiply organically—just as the early church did.

A CHURCH AMONG THE UNREACHED

This year, *Leading The Way* heard from one of the first known Christ-followers from the remote Tuareg tribe. A farmer in the Algerian desert, Ahmed had long-standing doubts about his native Islamic religion. When he began watching THE KINGDOM SAT, his friends warned him to avoid indulging poisonous beliefs. But Ahmed was captivated by this Jesus, who filled the emptiness in his heart.

Despite the opposition he faced from friends and family,
Ahmed was ready to give his life to Christ. He contacted a
member of our follow-up team, who traveled two days to meet
him in person and disciple him. "I belong to Jesus," Ahmed
told his family, "and nothing is going to take me from Him or
change my mind." Because of Ahmed's passion to follow
Jesus, he now leads a prayer and Bible study group of eight
members who accepted the Lord—the first church we know
of in this desert town.



REACHING MUSLIMS HERE AT HOME

Despite increasing persecution, many Muslims around the world are coming to Christ. In Indonesia, the world's largest Muslim nation, responses to our channel are increasing exponentially with the addition of new programs in the local language.

But this move of God is not only sweeping across North Africa and Asia. It is also happening in the hearts of Muslims here at home. This year, one viewer shared with us:

"I grew up as a Christian but converted to Islam five years ago. Now I am on the quest for Truth! Recently I came across your videos on YouTube. I was captivated until I could no longer watch since my Muslim husband was to arrive home from work. I will continue to listen to your lectures and take notes so I can compare Christianity to Islam. My conversion to Islam was very emotional. Now I want to find the facts. Thank God, I am enlightened and searching today! I want to boldly follow the Truth." - UNITED STATES

For every person who reaches out to our team, there are many more who, out of fear or caution, do not. The work is not easy. The soil of this harvest field can be hard to till. But through your prayers and support, God is doing a mighty work that we will never fully comprehend until the day when every tribe, tongue, and nation gathers before Him in worship.

Although we hear from thousands, we have many disciples who are unknown to us.

When you have searched desperately for Jesus and risked it all to finally find Him, you do not let Him go when the trials come—and He doesn't let you go, either.

That's the pervading theme we hear in the testimonies of those who have received help from Leading The Way's Help The Persecuted ministry, many of whom are converts from Islam. Their own words say it all.

"I'M NOT SCARED ANYMORE"

"I was beaten and locked up, often without food or water. Killing me would wash away the shame that I had brought upon my family. So I left the house, knowing that if anyone found me I'd be dead," said Fatima. "I left to find Christ. I wanted Him; I wanted to find Him, and I was so lost."

For Fatima, a young woman from Egypt, finding the Truth was worth risking it all. She watched THE KINGDOM SAT and kept in touch with our follow-up team. She received Dr. Youssef's booklet *Finding the Joy You've Always Wanted* and her life was forever changed. Her family beat her and tried to force her into a marriage with a Muslim cousin, but she didn't turn back.

"Peace used to be a word that I would just hear about, but now I know what it means," she said. "I used to be very scared of death, but now I wish for it because I know that I have gained eternal life, and I'm not scared anymore."

"MY PRAYER AT THAT TIME WAS 'JESUS"

From a young age, Rabi thought that if he could be the perfect Muslim, Allah would love him. But the more he learned about Islam, the more he realized that would never happen. He became disillusioned and desperate to know who God really was.

"I told Him, 'I don't know You, but You created me and You know me. Reveal Yourself to me,'" Rabi said. "I found my heart telling me, *Jesus*. My prayer at that time was just, 'Jesus.'"

"The first one to persecute me was my wife," Rabi said.
"She told her siblings and cousins, who ganged up on me and started beating me."



HELP IS HERE

Beaten and abused. Forced to leave home. Arrested, tortured, and imprisoned. Questioned by the government. Missions organizations report that more Muslims have come to Christ in the last 15 years than in the past 14 centuries. **But this harvest has come with a price.** According to human rights groups, **2015 was the worst year in modern history for Christian persecution.**

In addition to providing support for refugees and Christians who have fled ISIS, *Leading The Way* is also meeting the needs of individuals who are counting the cost for their conversion—many of whom have come to Christ as a result of *Leading The Way's* broadcasts to the Muslim world. This last year saw a **two-fold increase** in the number of cases our team responded to from **viewers of THE KINGDOM SAT.**

Through our *Help The Persecuted* ministry, believers like Fatima and Rabi are receiving not only practical help, but much-needed spiritual support along the way, too.

In addition to the living expenses *Leading The Way* provided to help her start over, Fatima recounted the encouragement she received through every step of her journey:

"Every time I felt sad, I would receive a message from the follow-up team, and it would give me hope," she said.

"Through *Leading The Way*, I found that someone was by my side every step of the way."

After Rabi came to Christ, his wife and children also gave their lives to the Lord, his marriage was restored, and his family is now sharing with others the Good News that changed their lives. The road hasn't been easy, but God has sustained them through it all.

"I felt lonely," said Rabi's wife, Azhara. "We lost our family . . . But we were short of nothing. The Lord took care of us in an amazing way."

"We met a brother from your team here in Egypt," said Rabi. "He gave us a gift and told us there are more blessings to come. All I know is that God is good. You are a blessing to many."
